CALL FOR PAPERS

The Francophone Music Criticism, 1789-1914 network will celebrate its tenth anniversary at a conference in advance of the annual meeting of the American Musicological Society in Rochester, New York. The network conference will take place on Wednesday 8 and Thursday 9 November, ending just before the beginning of the AMS meeting at 2.00 on 9 November.

Proposals for papers, groups of papers, workshops and other sorts of activities are invited on any topic with a connection to the press and relating to music in France during the long nineteenth century. Abstracts should be no more than 150 words, and should be sent to Mark Everist no later than Friday, 30 June 2017. We anticipate finalising the programme at the end of July 2017.
